Senate bill, File No. 391, entitled "An Act to appropriate the sum of twenty five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary to be expended by the Board of Public Works in repairing the wharf property adjacent to and occupied by State Tobacco Warehouses Nos. 1 and 2; and in replacing necessary furniture and fixtures in any of the State Tobacco Warehouses in Baltimore city, and making repairs to any of said State Tobacco Warehouses, the amount to be taken from the Tobacco Warehouse Fund."
