AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

To amend the title by striking out all after "repeal" in first line to the word "entitled" in the second line thereof:

"That following chapter 160 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1888."

Add a new section to be known as section 13 A to follow after section 13 and to read as follows:

"Section 13 A. And be it enacted that all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act be and the same are hereby repealed."
