AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

At the end of section 14, add

“Provided, that if the County Commissers of Anne Arundel county shall determine that it is more advantageous to the interests of the tax payers of the county to remove said bridge from its present location and construct the same as desired by United States Government and to be paid for by said United States Government, then this Act shall be null and void and the County Commissioners shall not be required to obey the provisions of this Act, and that any and all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.”
