A bill entitled "An Act to add two new sections to follow section 763, Article 4, chapter 123, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, of the session of 1898, title 'Charter of Baltimore City,' sub-title 'Police Commissioners,' as repealed and re-enacted by chapter 421 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the session of 1900, to be known as 'Sections 763 A and 763 B.'"
