

of chapter 18 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the session of 1901, entitled 'An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, sections 270 GG, sub-title 'Nominations;' sections 270 QQ, 270 RR, 270 TT, sub-title 'Ballot and Ballot Boxes,' and sections 270 CCC, 270 DDD, 270 IIII and 270 AAAAA, sub-title 'Elections' of chapter 2 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the Session of 1898, entitled 'An Act to repeal chapter 544 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, in the year 1894, entitled 'An Act to add new and additional sections to Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Frederick County,' sub-title 'Frederick,' relating to elections in Frederick city; and to enact in lieu thereof certain new and additional sections relating to the registration of voters and to elections in Frederick city aforesaid, to be added to said Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Frederick County,' sub-title 'Frederick,' to follow section 270 A of said Article, and to be known as 'Section 27 B, etc.'"
