A bill entitled "An Act to extend to Baltimore county the operation of section 152, 153, and 154, of Article 33, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Elections,' sub-title, 'Primary Elections.'"

Which was read a first time and referred to the Baltimore county delegation.

By Mr. Norris,

A bill entitled "An Act to add 3 new sections to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Baltimore city,' under the new sub-title, 'Street Railways,' to be designated as sections 796 A, 796 B and 796 C, and to follow section 796."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.

By Mr. Roth,

A bill entitled "An Act to amend Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' by repealing section 47 A, as enacted by chapter 73 of the Acts of 1896, and re-enacting the same with amendments, under the sub-title 'Desertion of Wife or Child,' and by adding thereto an additional section to follow immediately after section 47 A, and to be known as 'Section 47 B.'"

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
