To the Senate and House of Delegates of Md.

Gentlemen: The conference committee of the two houses on the disagreeing votes upon house amendments to Senate Bill File No. 223 beg leave to report as follows: We recommended that the House recede from its amendments and that the following be adopted.

That in line 8 of section 3 of said bill strike out the following words "By the governing body of each of the political parties" and insert the following:

"By the committeemen of each election district and the committeemen shall be elected at each primary election for each of the election districts of Montgomery county and each candidate for committeeman shall pay one dollar to the supervisors of election,

And in line 6, section 13 strike out the following words "or for any reason."
