In line 22, page 7, sub-title 'Miscellaneous,' after the word "dollars" insert the following "for salary of a stenographer and typewriter to State Comptroller seven hundred and twenty dollars."

On line 10, page 9, sub-title 'Miscellaneous' after the word "Comptroller," add the following words, "to the Bureau of Industrial Statistics, one thousand dollars for office furniture."
