House bill, File No. 752, entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Dorchester County,' to be known as 'Section 228 A,' under a new sub-title of 'Fraud on Livery Stable Keepers,' providing for the punishment of persons hiring horses or vehicles from livery stable keepers in Dorchester county, to go a certain distance, and using said horses or vehicles for a greater distance."
