Assembly, and to such accredited representatives of the Press as may apply in person therefor, an official pass signed by the Governor and bearing the Great Seal of Maryland, admitting the holder thereof to pass within the fire lines in the city of Baltimore and to inspect the ruins in the devastated district of said city. Such pass to be valid during the existence of said fire lines.

Which was adopted.
