The Speaker, from Committee on Rules reported favorably the following order.

Ordered, That section 31, of rule 41, be amended by striking out the word "nineteen" in the second line and inserting in lieu thereof the word "twenty," so as to make said section read as follows:

31. A committee on the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, to consist of twenty members, as follows: One from each of the Legislative districts of Baltimore city and one from each of the following counties: Baltimore, Anne Arundel, Charles, Calvest, St. Mary's, Harford, Cecil, Kent, Queen Anne, Talbot, Dorchester, Wicomico, Worcester, Somerset, Caroline and Prince George's.

Which was read and adopted.
