House bill, File No. 145, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 27 of chapter 157 of the Acts of the General Assembly, passed at the January Session 1900, entitled 'An Act to repeal sections 27 and 28, of Article 6 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'Caroline County,' sub-title 'Birds and Game,' and re-enact the same with amendments, and to add an additional section to said Article and to follow section 27, and to be numbered '27 A.'"
