BILLS—SECOND READING.

House bill, File No. 30, entitled “An Act to add an additional section to Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title ‘Crimes and Punishments,’ sub-title ‘Fraud,’ by adding a new section thereto, to be known as ‘Section 119 B.’”

Which was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

House bill, File No. 120, entitled “An Act to repeal sections 733 and 734, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title ‘Baltimore City,’ sub-title ‘Miscellaneous Laws,’ sub-division ‘Notaries Public,’ and to re-enact the same with amendments.”

To add an additional section to be known as ‘Section 2:’ “And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.”
