A bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 218, 219, 220, 221, 222 and 223 of Article 1, of the Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title 'Allegany County,' and to re-enact the same with amendments, to provide for the inauguration and maintenance of night schools in Allegany county."
