Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, section 4, Article 81, Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Revenue and Taxes,' sub-title 'Exemptions,' as repealed and re-enacted by chapter 120 of the Acts of 1896."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

By Mr. Tennant,

A bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, chapter 613, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January Session, 1890, the same being sections 403 to 423, inclusive, of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, as amended by said chapter 613 of said Acts of 1890, title 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Williamsport,' and also to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter 725 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January session, 1900.'"

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Washington delegation.

By Mr. Atkinson,

A bill entitled "An Act to prevent killing or trapping of foxes in Kent county."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Kent delegation, and Mr. Buckler.

By Mr. Atwell,

A bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the taking of oysters with scoop, scrape, dredge or similar instrument at any point in the Chesapeake Bay between Holland's Island Bar and the Three Sisters, and one and one-half miles from the western mainland."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Chesapeake Bay and Tributaries.
