for in the aforesaid Act of Congress and to use all possible effort to secure the location of said encampment in said Garrett county; and be it further resolved,

That the Governor of this State be and he is hereby respectfully requested to send a copy of these resolutions, properly engrossed, attested with the Great Seal of this State to each of the Senators and Representatives from Maryland, and also a copy to the Chief of Staff of the United States Army, and a copy to the Chairman of the Committee on Military Affairs of the United States House of Representatives.
