Chapter 6. "An Act to authorize the President and Commissioners of Chesapeake City to issue bonds of said town to pay off the indebtedness of said town, growing out of a suit of Mrs. Agnes T. Emmons and otherwise."

Chapter 7. "An Act to repeal and re-enact section 34 of the charter of the town of Gaithersburg, in Montgomery county, as enacted by chapter 526 of the laws of the General Assembly of 1898."
