A bill entitled "An Act to add three new sections to Article 18 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Queen Anne's County,' sub-title 'Roads,' to follow section 230, to be designated as 'Sections 230 A, 230 B and 230 C.'"

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Queen Anne's delegation.

By Mr. Bosse,

A bill entitled "An Act to prohibit pools, trusts, monopolies and conspiracies to control business and prices of articles; to prevent the formation or operation of pools, trusts, monopolies and combinations of charters of corporations that violate the terms of this Act, and authorize the institution of prosecutions and suits therefor."

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Corporations.
