House bill, File No. 169, entitled "An Act requiring roving bands of nomads, commonly called gypsies, and the persons composing such bands, who have no permanent place of abode in the State of Maryland, to take out a license to pitch or settle its or their encampment or carry on its or their transactions or practice their craft within the limits of Caroline county, and prescribe the penalty for a violation of the same."
