6. In line 35 of section 3, strike out the words, "for Caroline county."

Which was adopted.

7. In line 4 of section 4, before the word "Permanent," strike out the word "A" and insert in lieu thereof, the word "No."

Which was adopted.

8. Strike out all of section 5.

Which was adopted.

By Mr. Howard,

That the provisions of this Act shall not apply to Garrett county.

Which was adopted.

By Mr. Feaga,

"That the provisions of this Act shall not apply to Allegany county."

Which was adopted.

By Mr. Benson,

"That the provisions of this Act shall not apply to Baltimore county."

Which was adopted.

Which was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Speaker, presesented the evidence in the contested election case of Garner vs. Wilkinson.

Which was read and referred to the Committee on Elections.

The Secretary of the Senate appeared and delivered the following message:
