A bill entitled “An Act placing as a contingent fund at the disposal of the Governor, (as contemplated in section 32, Article 3 of the Constitution of Maryland) the sum of two hundred and fifty thousand (\$250,000) for the relief of cases of destitution and need caused by the fire in Baltimore of February 7th and 8th, 1904.”

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

By Mr. Dodson,

A bill entitled “An Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Talbot county, in the State of Maryland in their discretion, to construct a bridge across Roll’s Creek in Talbot county.”

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Talbot delegation.

By Mr. Kirbin,

A bill entitled “An Act to provide for an election to be held in Election District No. 8 of Worcester county, to determine by a ballot of qualified and registered voters in said district whether spirituous, fermented or intoxicating liquors of whatever origin or alcoholic bitters shall be sold therein.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Temperance.
