Senate bill, File No. 34, entitled "An Act to prohibit the laying of railway tracks upon Evergreen Terrace, between Fulton avenue and Orem lane or avenue, in the city of Baltimore, without the consent of the General Assembly of Maryland."

House bill, File No. 205, entitled "An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within the limits of Ballinger District or Election District No. 23 in Frederick county, Md."
