A bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 180, 181, 182, 206 A, 217, 237, 245, 246 and 257 of Article 11 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Frederick County,' sub-title 'Frederick,' and to enact the following in lieu thereof and in addition thereto."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Frederick delegation.

Also,

A bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors, or lager beer, or intoxicating drinks of any kind, at any place in Frederick county, within two miles of the public school house in Urbana district of said county, known as sugar loaf or mountain school house, otherwise known as school No. 6 in election district No. 7 of said county, and also to prohibit the giving away or distributing of such spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, or intoxicating drinks of any kind, at or near the place of business of any person within the limits aforesaid."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on Temperance.
