Senate bill, File No. 101, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 1, 3 and 4 of chapter 157 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at the January Session, 1900, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Annapolis Banking and Trusts Company.'"
