Unfavorable report adopted.

House bill, File No. 10, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 42 of Article 77 of the Code of Public General Laws, title Public Education."

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Goslin, from Ways and Means Committee, reported favorably,

House bill, Fite No. 276, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 4 of chapter 102 of the Acts of 1896, entitled 'An Act to provide for formation of Farmers' Institutes in the State of Maryland, and to appropriate a sum of money therefor, as amended by chapter 363 of the Acts of 1900."

Which was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Also favorably, with amendment.
