

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out the word "ten" where it appears in line 6 of section 1, and line 21 of section 1, and in line 42 of section 1, and in line 45 of section 1, and in line 55 of section 1, and in line 57 of section 1, and insert in lieu thereof in each of said places the words "four."

Which amendment was adopted, bill read second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
