House bill, File No. 268, entitled "An Act to repeal sections 1, 8 and 9 of chapter 160 of the Acts of 1902, entitled 'An Act to create and establish the State Board of Undertakers of Maryland, and to prescribe the powers and duties of the said board, and to re-enact the same with amendments.' "

Also favorably,

House bill, File No. 267, entitled "An Act to authorize the Local Boards of Health of the counties and the County Commissioners of the several counties where they exercise such powers to designate and appoint as sub-registrars to issue burial permits, the physician or physicians residing in, attending on or appointed to any college, academy or boarding school, hospital, retreat, asylum, sanatorium or other like place in their respective counties, and to prescribe rules and fix charges for such permits."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
