Senate, bill, File No. 110, entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter 307 of the Laws of Maryland passed at the January Session 1890, entitled 'An Act to require the Commissioners of Talbot county to pay annually to the Commissioners of Easton the amount of road tax levied or taxed upon the property within the limits of the town of Easton."
