Senate bill, File No. 104, entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Isaac Benesch & Sons, Frank A. Munroe and the Evening Capital, for furniture and so forth furnished the Senate and House of Delegates of Maryland."

House bill, File No. 6, entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to pay Noah C. Sterling for the loss of the vessel 'Martha E. Freeman.'"

House bill, File No. 321, entitled "An Act to appropriate a certain sum of money to repair and put in good condition the State Hay Scales, at Havre de Grace."

Which was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Also unfavorably,

House bill, File No. 365, entitled "An Act to encourage manufacturing in the State of Maryland by exempting the plant and machinery of manufacturing industries bordering on navigable rivers from county taxation."
