A bill entitled "An Act to add new sections to chapter 178 of the Acts of 1896, entitled 'An Act to incorporate the town of Ridgely, Caroline County, Maryland, by providing for the issuing and sale of bonds by the Commissioners of Ridgely for erecting and maintaining waterworks in said town and authorizing the said commissioners to condemn such land as may be necessary for the building of said works.'"
