

Senate bill, File No. 76, entitled "An Act to repeal sections 175 A, 175 B, 175 C, 175 D, 175 G, 175 L and 175 P, of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title 'Alleghany County,' under the sub-title 'Intoxicating Liquors,' as enacted by the Acts of 1894, chapter 140, the Acts of 1896, chapter 118, and the Acts of 1902, chapter 415, and to re-enact the same with amendments."
