

## AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Strike out the words and figures "twenty-five dollars," and on page 2 line 2 and insert in lieu thereof the words and figures "fifty dollars, (\$50)."

House bill, File No. 34, entitled "An Act to empower the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to acquire by condemnation or otherwise additional lots of ground within the city of Baltimore, for the erection of fire engine houses, and to erect fire engine houses thereon, and to purchase permanent equipments for extinguishing fires, including a new fire boat; and for such purposes or any of them to appropriate from time to time subject to the jurisdiction of the Board of Estimates, out of the sum of four million, four hundred and twenty-two thousand, four hundred and sixty dollars and seventy-four cents, (\$4,422,460.74) forming part of the purchase price paid by the Fuller Syndicate for the interests of the city of Baltimore in the Western Maryland Railroad Company, and heretofore passed to the credit of the general sinking fund of said city, sums not exceeding in the whole two hundred and fifty thousand (\$250,000) dollars."
