A bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 16 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, to be known as 'Section 198 A,' and to follow immediately after section 198 of said Article, relating to the power of Courts of Equity to authorize the mortgaging of lands belonging to estates."

A bill entitled "An Act to enable qualified voters of the town of Brunswick, Frederick county, Maryland, to determine by ballot whether spirituous or fermented liquors, lager beer or alcoholic bitters shall be sold in said town or within two miles of the corporate limits thereof, except in the village of Knoxville and to regulate the terms and conditions on which
