Senate bill, File No. 197, entitled “An Act to authorize James M. Budd to build a wharf at Budd’s Landing on the Cecil county side of the Sassafras river.”

Which was read the first time and referred to the Cecil delegation.

Senate bill, File No. 212, entitled “An Act to repeal sections 49 and 50 of Article 25 of the Public General Laws of Maryland, title ‘County Commissioners,’ sub-title ‘Draining Lands,’ as amended by the Act of 1892, chapter 649, so far as the same apply to tax ditches or drains situate wholly within Somerset county, and to enact in lieu thereof certain provisions applicable to such tax ditches or drains situate wholly within said county.”
