A bill entitled "An Act to empower, authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Charles county, to levy at their next levy, at laying a sum of money to the use of Alice M. Cox, trustee of the estate of Samuel H. Cox, late of Charles county, deceased, paid by the said Alice M. Cox, as said trustee, into the County Treasury of Charles county in error."
