Insert in line 5 of section 2, after the word "operate" the word "such."

Which was adopted.

Sec. 13. After the Stock Subscription Book is turned over the Commissioners to the Board of Directors of this Company, said Board of Directors or their authorized agent may receive subscription for stock to be paid in cost or in real and personal estate.

Sec. 14. And be it enacted that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
