Senate bill, File No. 165, entitled "An Act to repeal section 21 of Article 10, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled 'Attorney's,' sub-title 'States Attorney' so far as the same applies to Washington county, and to add and enact in lieu thereof two additional sections to the Code of Public Local Laws; Article 22, title 'Washington County,' providing a fixed salary for the State's Attorney and abolishing compensation by fees."

Senate bill, File No. 178, entitled "An Act to create a commission on the burnt district of Baltimore city; to define its duties and powers; to regulate its methods of procedure; to define the extent of said district; to provide for opening, laying out, extending, widening, straightening and closing streets, lanes and alleys; for establishing public squares and market spaces, building lines and the width of sidewalks in said district; for adding to, extending and partly filling the harbor or basin of Baltimore city; and for establishing public wharves and docks, and to provide for appropriating a portion of the general sinking fund of Baltimore city and other monies for the purpose of this Act."
