Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

House bill, File No. 450, entitled "An Act to regulate the erection, construction and maintenance of private and public buildings in the Twelfth and Fourteenth Election Districts of Baltimore county, and to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of said county to adopt rules and regulations in reference thereto, and to provide for the appointment and compensation by fees of Inspectors of Buildings for said district, and require that the erection and construction of all buildings in said districts shall be under their supervision and subject to the regulations of said County Commissioners, and further to provide for the construction of fire-escapes for school houses throughout Baltimore county."
