the qualified voters of Garrett county to determine by ballot whether bonds not to exceed the sum of \$175,000, shall be issued by the Commissioners of said county for the purpose of building and furnishing a new court house and jail at the county seat. Oakland, in said county."

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill, File No. 210, entitled "An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer or intoxicating drinks of any kind at any place in Frederick county, within two miles of the public school house in Urbana district of said county known as Sugar Land or Mountain School House otherwise known as school No. 6 in election district No. 7 of said county, and also to prohibit the giving away or distributing of such spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer or intoxicating drinks of any kind at or near the place of business of any person within the limits aforesaid."
