

and keeping in repair the public roads of Worcester county and to repeal all laws not inconsistent therewith so far as the same apply to Worcester county,' and to add a new section thereto to follow immediately after section 7 and to be known as 'Section 7 A.' "

Which was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

House bill, File No. 571, entitled "An Act to authorize, empower and direct the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county, to grant a pension of fifty dollars to Wm. H. Nichols of said county and to levy said amount on the assessable property of said county."

Mr. Harry, from Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill, File No. 191, entitled "An Act to add additional sections to the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Frederick County,' under a new sub-title to be designated 'Coroners and Justice of the Peace,' regulating certain duties of Coroners and Justice of the Peace acting as Coroners for Frederick county, also regulating fees of physicians in said county attending coroners inquests.

Which was read the second time.

House bill, File No. 515, entitled "An Act to repeal section 56 A, of Article 9, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Charles County Commissioners and County Treasurers,' as the same was enacted by Act of 1898, chap. 384, under the title 'An Act to add a new section to Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Charles County,' sub-title 'County Commissioners,' to follow section 56 and to be designated as 'Section 56 A,' and in lieu thereof to enact and add another section relating to the printing and publish-
