And, upon the side of said pedestal the following: "Attorney General of Maryland, 1827,

Attorney General of U.S. 1831;" and

Be it resolved, That the cost of said inscription, not to exceed seventy-five dollars, shall be paid by the Governor out of the contingent fund at the disposal of the Executive.
