The United States of America are many in one. Our life is made interesting by our variety and strong by our unity. Our sphere is guided by our ideas and ideals, our hopes and aspirations, our faith and brotherhood of cooperation. If we are true to America, to the teachings of our fathers, we shall really inherit the earth.
