With hearts dedicated to the ideals of peace and justice for all mankind we can lift our eyes, unashamed, in this our time of trial, to the Omnipotent Being who disposes all our efforts, and say to Him, in the words of that inspiring hymn, America:

"Protect us by thy might,
Great God our King !"
