On motion by Mr. Steiner,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to be entitled an Act to authorize the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick to borrow a sum of money, not exceeding in the aggregate fifteen thousand dollars, to meet the cost of an additional introduction and distribution of water in the City of Frederick, and to issue bonds for the same.

On motion by Mr. Wilson,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judicial Proceedings to introduce a bill to be entitled an Act to give the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to a gift of seventy-five shares of the stock of the National Mechanics' Bank of Baltimore, to the vestry of St. Paul's Parish, in Calvert County.

Mr. Gorman, from the Committee on Corporations, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act to authorize a reduction of the capital stock of the New Central Coal Company, passed at January Session, 1874, Chapter 287, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Bannon, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to remove all gates from the public roads of Anne Arundel County.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Wilson, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal an Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, of 1876, Chapter 62, entitled an Act to prevent the increase of gates upon the public roads of Calvert County.

Which was read the first time.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 138, of the Acts passed at the January Session, 1874, Chapter 483, entitled an Act to repeal Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, of the State of Maryland, entitled "Revenue and Taxes," and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to amend and re-enact the said Section 138,

Being upon its second reading,
