Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Worcester County to erect and maintain a bridge over Herring Creek in said county, and to levy a sum of money therefor.

Senate bill entitled an Act to prohibit Life Insurance Companies from contesting the payment of losses on policies, after having received premiums thereon for two years.
