AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

In line 11, after "State," insert the words "Provided in no case a reduction of more than fifty per cent. be allowed by the Comptroller."

Which was rejected by year and nays as follows:

Said bill, as amended, was then read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Senate bill entitled an Act to prescribe and define the duties of the Comptroller of the Treasury, relative to the apportionment and distribution of the revenue derived from the annual tax levied for the support of free public schools, and to confirm the apportionments and distributions thereof heretofore made by that officer.
