Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the Governor to appoint an additional Justice of the Peace in the Second Election District of Queen Anne's County.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact Sections 3 and 4, of an Act passed by the General Assembly of Maryland, at its January Session, 1876, entitled an Act to incorporate the purchasers of the Queen Anne's and Kent Railroad, and to further amend said Act of Assembly, by adding an additional section thereto.

Senate bill entitled an Act supplementary to an Act of 1812, Chapter 159, entitled an Act for founding an University in the City or precincts of Baltimore, by the name of the University of Maryland, and to authorize the regents of the University of Maryland to apply a portion of the property held by said University to the general uses of said University and to sell said property, and apply the proceeds to the general uses of said University.
