House bill entitled an Act to repeal Chapter 262, of the Public General Laws of the State of Maryland of 1872, entitled an Act to ratify and confirm the appointment by the Governor of Daniel Clarke and Sidney I. Wailes, as Commissioners in behalf of the State of Maryland, to prosecute the settlement of the claims of said State against the Government of the United States, for expenses incurred under the Act of Congress, approved on the 27th of July, 1861, &c.
