Also, delivered

House bill entitled an Act to protect the oysters in the waters of the Great and Little Choptank rivers, and prohibit the taking thereof in the months of June, July and August, except for bedding the same in the waters of the Great and Little Choptank rivers.

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on the Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries.

House bill entitled an Act to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Charles County to pay to Thomas Skinner, of said county, the sum of \$100, for money paid by him to sundry persons for the killing of hawks, owls, foxes, &c., in 1876 and 1877.
