Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Chapter 164, of the Acts passed at January Session, 1867, relating to payment of costs incurred before Justices of the Peace before appeal can be heard and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal Section 7, of Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Costs," providing for costs in criminal cases, and to amend and re-enact the same.
